2014/15 TRAINING CALENDAR

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: enrolments for ALL courses need to be completed 2 weeks before the course starts. Minimum numbers are required for courses to run.

<u>Apply First Aid</u> (minimum age 14 years) one day course on *Sunday 3rd August*. Maximum number for course is 25.

<u>Training Officers' Course</u> (minimum age 16 years) is being held at BALLINA BRANCH TRAINING ROOM on Sunday 24th August. *Please contact the office immediately to enrol in this course.*

<u>Advanced Resuscitation Techniques Certificate</u> (minimum age 15 years) one day course (hopefully) *on Saturday 30th August*. Maximum number for course is 16.

<u>Surf Rescue Certificate</u> (minimum Age 13 years) 5 week course beginning *Sunday 31st August*; assessment on 28th September. Minimum number for course is 4, maximum 8. A 200 metre pool swim time of less than 5 minutes must be completed before the course.

<u>Bronze Medallion</u> (minimum age 15 years) 7 week course beginning *Sunday 19th October*, assessment on 7th December. Minimum number for course is 4, maximum 10. A second Bronze course may be held from *Sunday 1st February*, assessment on 22nd March.

A 400 metre pool swim time of less than 9 minutes must be completed before the course.

Other, Branch courses will be advertised by the Branch. If you wish to do an Advanced First Aid, a Spinal Management or a Basic Beach Management course please let the office know.

<u>IRB (Crew and Drivers)</u> are run on a needs basis. Please contact James Ryan directly if you wish to do an IRB course. WE DO NEED MORE CREWIES AND DRIVERS TO MEET PATROL EXPECTATIONS.

GYM MEMBERSHIP

Gym membership/use is available to financial club members who satisfy the relevant conditions.

All **gym** members must complete **club membership** form and payment prior to joining as gym members.

Both club membership AND gym membership forms are available in the gym or from the office.

Gym fees are as follows:

3 months \$60 + club membership fee 12 months \$200 + club membership fee

*Minimum gym membership is for a 3 month block

*Gym membership is per CALENDAR month only

Active patrolling gym users must satisfy patrol requirements, complete a gym renewal form for THIS season and pay club membership fees to be eligible for free gym use.

Current monthly gym lists are posted in the gym each month.

CLUB LOCKERS

There are a limited number of clubhouse lockers for members available for hire for \$15 per year. Members who have existing lockers are asked to pay this fee and their membership fees for the new 2014-15 season ASAP.
