Whilst this new lease is negotiated Crown Lands and Clarence Valley Council have agreed to transfer the surf club lease to the Clarence Coast Reserve Trust, for which Council is the Corporate Trust Manager. The Trust will facilitate a temporary licence with the club to enable ongoing tenure until such time as a new lease is finalised.

#### **North Coast Surf Boat Series**

The Yamba boat crews have started the season with a bang with 5 crews rowing at Rounds 1 and 2 of the Series at our home beach on October 18/19. The same 5 crews - Opens, Reserves, Women's and the two Masters crews - also competed at Rounds 3 and 4 of the Series held at Scotts Head on November 15/16. The Over 160 years masters crew have been rowing well to lead the pointscore in their division whilst the Womens crew won both their finals at Scotts Head in an impressive display of rowing. Club boat sweeps Rod McSkimming, Ray Wiblen and Mick Smith have had a busy start to the season. Next round of the series is at Pacific Palms in the Lower North Coast branch on December 13/14. The Under 23 crew, who have been rowing in the Open division at the Series, will revert back to their own age group for the big Coffs Harbour Craft Carnival on November 29/30. The Reserve grade crew will also compete at Coffs Harbour.

#### Coolangatta Gold

Well done to club members who competed in the teams section of the Coolangatta Gold on the weekend of November 1/2. Congratulations Peter Rheinberger, Todd Ives, Mitch Imeson, Brent Sahlqvist and Paul Cromack. SLSA have announced that next years Coolangatta Gold will be held on October 10/11.

#### **Branch Surf Carnivals**

A small Yamba team competed at the Byron Bay surf carnival on November 9. Placings went to Peter Rheinberger 2nd in O/40 surf race; Will Brighton 2nd in U19 board race and beach flags; Ben Webster 2nd in U19 beach sprint; and Max Normand 3rd in U19 board race. The next branch carnival will be at Cudgen on Sunday December 21. If we have sufficient numbers the club will take a bus to the carnival.

#### **NSW Country Titles**

The Country Titles are on at Mollymook on the South Coast on January 16/18. Any competitors interested in making the trip to Mollymook should advise Jim Dougherty by December 31. Entries close with SLS NSW on January 6.

#### Yamba Ocean Swim

The Yamba Ocean Swim day is Sunday December 28. The 700 metre Convent Beach to Main Beach swim starts at 10am and the 2,000 metre race at 11am. This race is over a rectangular course starting and finishing in front of the surf club. The days events conclude with the 150 metre Dash for Cash at 12 noon. This is our biggest club event of the season and it requires a big workforce to successfully run the day. Two patrols have been rostered on duty on that morning to handle the big crowd. The last few years we have been short of water safety board paddlers and ski paddlers. Any paddlers who can help out with water safety should advise club captain James Ryan.

#### **Australian Titles**

The Australian Titles are to be held from April 11-19 at North Kirra beach on the Gold Coast. This season it will be a 9 day event for the first time.

Saturday/Sunday - Australian Youth Titles for Under 14s and Under 15s

Monday/Tuesday - Australian Masters Titles for Over 30s

Wednesday to Sunday - Open/Under 19/Under 17 Australian Titles

SLSA has also announced the venues for the following two years:

2016 - Maroochydore Qld - April 16-24

2017 - North Kirra, Qld - dates to be confirmed.

Applicants must be at least 16 years and hold a current Bronze Medallion/Cert 11. Further details on this course will be sent out next week.

I have been asked by numerous people if this course is to be run, so here is your chance to put your hand up and be counted, if sufficient numbers are received we will set a date and venue. Things to remember the prerequisites are to be proficient in the following, BM/Cert11, Apply[Senior]First Aid, SMPC or SMBBM, ARTC and Spinal Management and be at least 17 years. Further details will be out next week. This could also include any member who holds the award and wishes to do his proficiency.
