...from the EDUCATION DIRECTOR (Chief Training Officer)

So far this season we have held Apply First Aid, Advanced Resuscitation and Surf Rescue courses at Yamba, with all candidates being successful. Next is a Bronze Medallion course which is due to begin next Sunday, 9 am at the surf club.

Candidates are requested to have visited the office before Sunday to fill out a training enrolment form and to purchase a new manual for \$30. They also need to be timed swimming 400 metres; the time to be written down, signed by the person who timed the swim and given to the trainer on Sunday.

This will be a 7 week course involving 2 sessions per week with the assessment set for December 7th.

Please note that provision is made in the training calendar for extra SRC and BM courses to be run later in the season, if we have sufficient candidates to run these courses. Please contact the office to show your interest.

Other, Branch Courses have been opened if you would like to enrol in them. They are:

Spinal Management; venue Lennox Head SLSC on Saturday 8th November 2014

Prerequisites for the course are 15 years and hold either BM Cert II or Apply [Senior] First Aid. Names, Club and contact details [email] to be returned prior to **28th October 2014**, this will enable candidates to complete any pre course work required. Clubs should also verify that their members do hold the necessary prerequisites for the course.

Apply [Senior] First Aid, venue Branch Training rooms Shelly Beach Ballina on Sunday 16th November 2014.

Prerequisites for the course are 14 years. Names, Club and contact details [email] are to be returned prior to **31st October 2014.** This is necessary as there is a online component to be completed prior to attending the course.
