## **Working with Children Information**

A major change to the 'Working with Children Check' (WWCC) for NSW Surf Life Saving has been phased in this year. All NSW SLS members and employees (over 18) working with children for extended periods of time will need to complete a check. This applies to those in coaching/ teaching/ mentoring roles and youth/nippers age managers, assistants and water safety helpers. Basically, all those in our club involved with children under 18 years of age.

#### How to Apply:

i) Apply for a WWCC online at www.kidguardian.nsw.gov.au/check

ii) Take the form to a Motor Registry (RMS) with 100 points of ID or a Driver's License. When you are given a clearance you will be emailed a WWCC number. (There is no charge for volunteers.)

iii) Give a copy to the Surf Club so your registration number and expiry date can be recorded. This clearance will last 5 years.

This is a relatively quick and simple process, so members are urged to attend to this as soon as possible.



#### ... from the DIRECTOR of EDUCATION and TRAINING

A discussion between the Director of Junior Activities, Danielle Connolly, the Youth Development Officer, Kim McFarlane and myself, resulted in the following decisions, which have been ratified by the Board.

1. The under 13 "nippers" will do their Resuscitation Certificate as part of their junior activities on Sunday mornings.

2. The under 14s will do the SRC before Christmas and their Radio Operators after the Christmas break. If (1) above is agreed to the age managers should help to train these groups and gain their Training Officers Certificate in doing so.

3. A flow chart of the awards our members can gain at Yamba should be produced and distributed through Junior Activities.

4. The date of this year's SRC assessment be postponed to 13/12/'15, the same day as the Bronze Medallion assessment.

Bronze training continues on Saturdays, 9.30 to 12.30, while SRC training is on Sundays, 9 to noon. All candidates need to attend the remaining 4 sessions.

Flow charts showing the Awards offered by the Club and the FNC Branch will be added to the Club's website. These should guide members as to which courses they are able to apply for. These will be (were?) presented to the members at the General Meeting on 15/11/15

The final club proficiency is being held on 29/11/'15. All active members who have not completed their proficiency should be at the club by 8.30 am.
