#### Yamba Triathlon

This year the registration, transition and finish area will be in the Whiting Beach car park rather than at Ford Park. Swim course will again be at Whiting Beach. IRB drivers and crewies, RWC operators, board paddlers, ski paddlers, SUP paddlers etc. are needed for water safety for the various triathlon races.
